CAPS COOLGARDIE - February 21st

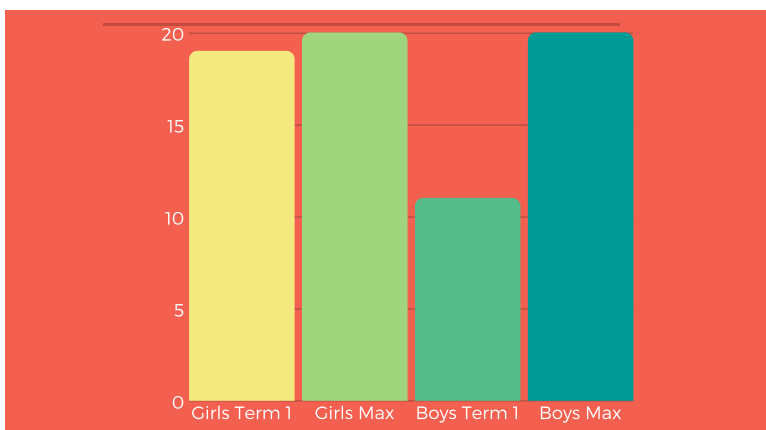
PRINCIPAL NOTE

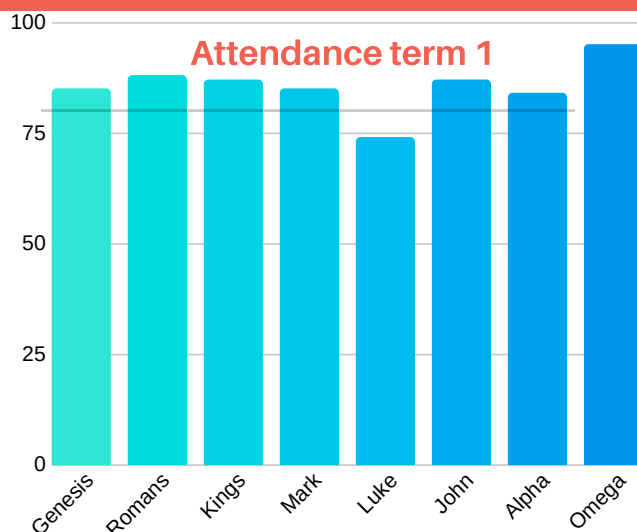
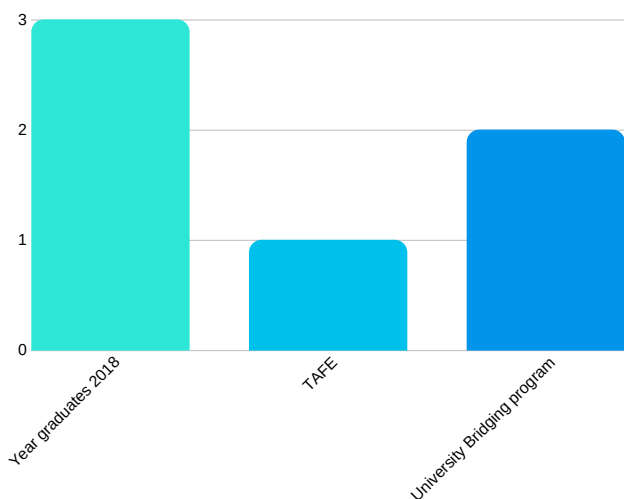
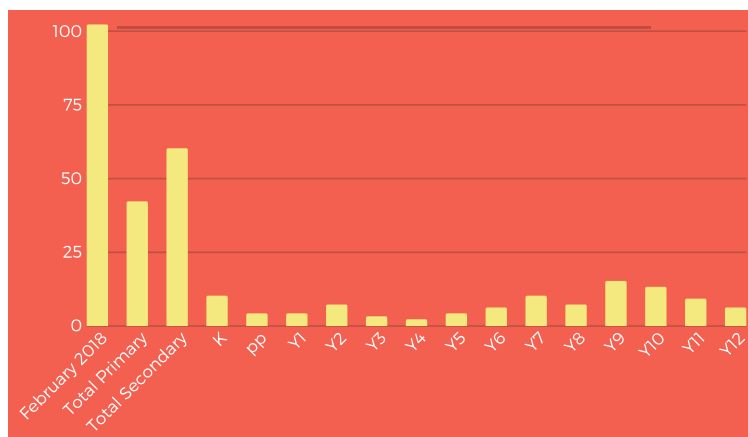
Mission

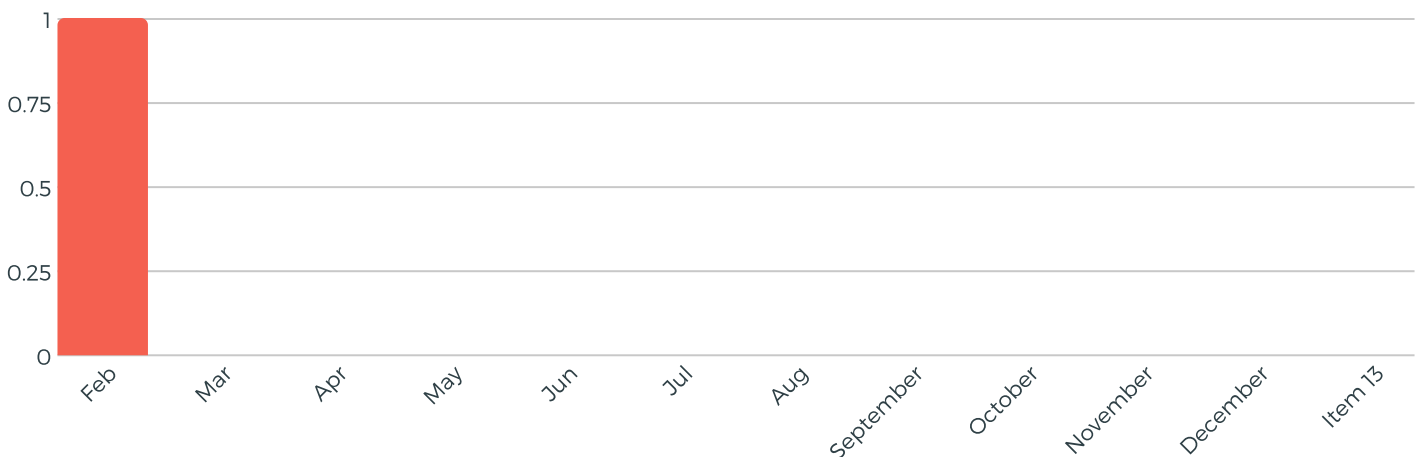
